The number one need is to solicit a volunteer from each of our buildings to be a part of the communication team. This team will keep residents advised of existing conditions in the event of a disaster. Will you help us? To volunteer, please call Toni Fowler (808-874-3700).

It is also important that our off island owners are kept advised in the event of a disaster and this will be done via e-mail rather than by telephone. If you have not done it already, you can help us by providing the office with your e-mail address.

The committee is recommending that GCV owners equip their condos with batteryoperated lights and a transistor AM/FM radio. It is also recommended that you have a three-day supply of bottled water and water purification tablets. As we saw how people flocked to the grocery stores, we feel it is important to be prepared in your own household.
